The Periodic Review Board, by consensus, determined that continued law of war detention of the detainee is no longer necessary to protect against a continuing significant threat to the security of the United States.

In making this determination, the Board recognizes the detainee presents some level of threat in light of his past activities and associations. However, the Board found that considering the standard it must apply and the following factors and conditions of the transfer, the detainee is eligible for transfer and the threat the detainee presents can be adequately mitigated. The Board expressed confidence in the efficacy of the Saudi rehabilitation program, the Board understood that Saudi Arabia can provide comprehensive mental health care, and the Board noted Saudi Arabia's ability to monitor the detainee after completion of the rehabilitation program. Also, the Board considered the detainee's significantly compromised mental health condition and available family support.

The PRB recommends the following conditions that relate to the detainee's transfer: Transfer only to Saudi Arabia for participation in the Mohammed bin Naif Counseling and Care Center, or a comparable program, to include provision of mental health care through implementation of a robust treatment plan and implementation of a comprehensive set of security measures including monitoring and travel restrictions.
